

Adults please carry this page with you while traveling to the Bahamas. It has information that you will need.

1. IF your flight is delayed an hour or more please call us at 1-919-647-4331. It is important for us to keep informed of your travel status. You might get our voice mail. If so, please leave a message and a contact number. (The phone number is a US number that rings to us in the Bahamas. It will not cost you anything to call this number on your cell phone.)
2. At the Marsh Harbour airport, please give this to your taxi driver:

Dear Taxi Driver:

This is our charter group. Please call "Captain Thomas" on channel 74. We will instruct you where to bring our group so we can pay you. We usually have you meet us at the Union Jack Dock or it is sometimes called the Government Dock. Many know it as it use to be called the Golden Harvest Dock. But this drop off location will change if it is raining. So call us on the radio to verify. There should be a total of 3 or 4 taxis for our group. Please make sure all the taxis follow to the same location to be paid.

Please call "Captain Thomas" on channel 74.

## Ciganka Check List

Believe it or not, your Ciganka High Adventure Sailing trip is right around the corner. Now is the time to make sure everyone is organized. Getting everything in order now will eliminate confusion and headaches later. Our goal is to assist you in making the preparation easy and fun!

- Collect the final payment from all the participants. Final payment due 60 days prior to your charter date.
- Make check payable to: The Sailing Ship Charter Co.

- Make sure everyone has a valid passport!** You cannot travel to the Bahamas or back to the US without a passport. Everyone must bring their passport.
- All participants must print off these two forms, fill them out completely, have them signed, and turn them into the adult leader in charge. One adult leader must carry these with them on the trip. Go to [www.sailingadventures.org](http://www.sailingadventures.org) Click on "What to Bring" link

- Have all participants print out **Leader, Crew, and Parent's Guide**. Each participant should read this through with their parents/guardian. It has all kinds of important info and emergency contact information.
- Have each participant print off the **Packing List** from the website and follow it exactly!
- \$27 per person Bahamian departure tax you will have to pay at the airport. Must be paid in cash.
- Email the Travel Itinerary. Click on "Secure Your Charter" link and fill our form under "Travel Arrangements". If the whole group is traveling together, we only need one filled out. But if there are more than 1 travel times for various people, we need the itinerary for each. We must have this information before the group leaves the states.
- Put together an adequate first aid kit that covers the needs of your group and bring it with you for your charter. Adult leaders -if you drink coffee please bring a non-breakable mug with Carabineer so it can be hung on the life line with the water bottles.
- Elect your "Crew Chief"
- Have adult leader bring \$100 check or cash for damage deposit.
- For adult leaders - Please remember to carry the first page of the Ciganka Check List with you while traveling. It has information that you will need if you have any flight delays and information you will need for the taxi drivers at the Marsh Harbour airport.
